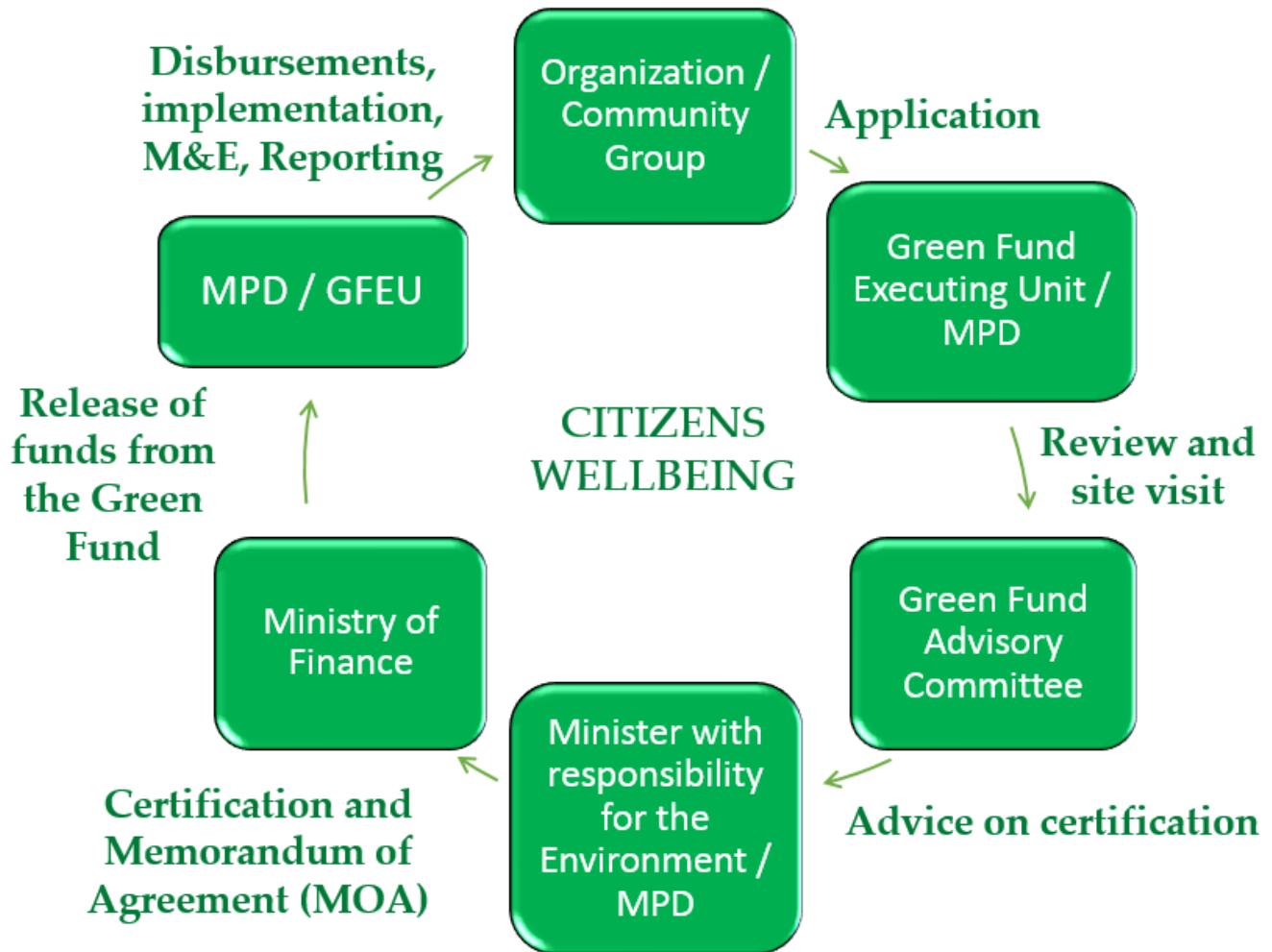
## GREEN FUND FOCAL AREAS.

- ❖ Reforestation.
- ❖ Environmental education and public awareness on environmental issues.
- ❖ Conservation.

## ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATIONS.

- ❖ Non-Governmental organizations (Registered with the Ministry or the Division with responsibility for Community Development).
- ❖ Community based organizations (Registered with the Ministry or the Division with responsibility for Community Development).
- ❖ Non-Profit organization (Registered with the Ministry of Legal Affairs).
- ❖ Enacted organizations (Registered under any other act other than the Companies Act e.g. An Act of Parliament).

- ❖ Organizational Chart
- ❖ Project Location Map

- ❖ Key Personnel Résumés of position job specifications
- ❖ Budget Quotations/Supporting Documents
- ❖ Proof of Stakeholder(s) Participation
- ❖ Letter(s) of Interest from key persons or organizations proposed to be contracted and proposed fees (if applicable)
- ❖ Project Proposal Document (if applicable)
- ❖ Previous Project/Funding History Reports (if applicable)
- ❖ Authorization from relevant authorities e.g. Access/use of lands at project site (if applicable)
- ❖ Certificate of Environmental Clearance (if applicable)
- ❖ Reports of Community/Stakeholder Consultations, re: project support (if applicable).
